Scholarship Criteria & Procedures

Scholarships in the amount of \$500 each will be awarded by the Waterloo Chamber of Commerce to three graduating seniors from Waterloo High School who meet the following criteria:

1. Be a graduating senior of Waterloo High School.
2. Member of Future Business Leaders of America or Future Farmers of America.
3. Enrolled in a two or four-year degree program for the next semester.
4. Volunteered a minimum of 16 hours during any Waterloo Chamber sponsored events. This could include Wiener & Kraut Day, the Community Expo, the Egg Hunt, Merchant Trick-or-Treat, the Holiday Parade, etc. The Chamber secretary will have a list of events that qualify. These hours must be accumulated during the 12-month period from May 1st of the student's junior year through April 30th of their senior year in high school.

Selection Process:

1. Applicants should send in completed forms to the Chamber office by June 4th of their senior year. The Chamber Board reviews applicants and chooses up to three (3) to receive scholarships.
2. Winners will be notified by letter.
3. A Chamber member or a High School representative presents the scholarship(s) at High School Awards Day.

Procedure for Check Disbursement: (paid at the beginning of the recipient's second college semester)

1. During their first college semester, the student must have earned a minimum of 12 credits with a 2.5 grade point average at their university or technical college of choice.
2. The student must submit to the Chamber office a copy of their transcript at the end of their first semester.
3. The Chamber Secretary will mail a check to the student.
