Summary of Process. A variance is a relaxation of a standard in a land use ordinance. Variances are decided by the zoning board of adjustment/appeals. The zoning board is a quasi-judicial body because it functions like a court. The board's job is not to compromise ordinance provisions for a property owner's convenience but to apply legal criteria provided in state laws, court decisions and the local ordinance to a specific fact situation. Variances are meant to be an infrequent remedy where an ordinance imposes a unique and substantial burden.

The applicant has:

- 1. Completed an application form and submit a fee.
- 2. Provided plans describing the project (location, dimensions, and materials).
- 3. Provided a written statement; and
- 4. A notice was published in the official newspaper noting the time and location of a required public hearing. The burden will be on the applicant to provide information upon which the board may base its decision. At the hearing, any party may appear in person or may be represented by an agent or attorney. The board must make its decision based only on the evidence submitted to it at the time of hearing.
