Over the past year, heroin forums have been held in communities such as Waukesha, Jefferson, Hartland, Watertown and Franklin. Prompted by these efforts and the disturbing fact that heroin overdose deaths have **increased 880% since 2006**, with 281 heroin overdose deaths statewide in 2016, we decided to take a closer look at our own community.

We will be holding a Stairway to Heroin community event at **Waterloo High School on October 24, 2017 from 6:00-8:30 PM** which will be free and open to all community members 12 years of age and older. A resource fair will precede the event beginning at 6:00 PM. The Stairway to Heroin educational events have been very successful in neighboring communities so we are hoping to continue to offer these awareness, education and prevention opportunities in our community to help the fight against the growing opiate epidemic.
