Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

You must make a request for an absentee ballot in writing.

Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the primary or election or both. You may also submit a written request in the form of a letter. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. You may make application for an absentee ballot by mail, email or in person.

Making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail

The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is: 5 pm on the fifth day before the election, THURSDAY, AUGUST 9, 2018.

Note: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

Voting an absentee ballot in person

You may also request and vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office or other specified location during the days and hours specified for casting an absentee ballot in person.

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election.





### Chapter 30. Common Council

#### § 30-8. Procedure to fill vacancies on Common Council.

- A. The Common Council shall oversee the application process to fill aldermanic vacancies.
- B. Applications to fill any aldermanic vacancy shall include:
  - (1) Name, address, home and work telephone numbers and e-mail address;
  - (2) A statement on why the applicant wishes to serve.
- C. Interested parties shall have 30 days to submit an application once a vacancy is announced. At the conclusion of the submittal period, applicants will be invited to the next Common Council meeting to answer any questions from the Common Council members. In accordance with § 19.85(1)(c), Wis. Stats., the Common Council may meet in closed session to review applications.
- D. The appointed and confirmed candidate shall serve until an Alderperson is elected pursuant to § 17.23(1), Wis. Stats., and is qualified.
