

On Monday September 9th, 2019 we had our monthly EMS training. Training consisted of four scenarios and with each one the EMS crew had to give a radio report. All of the scenarios were out in the area which gave our drivers more training. The first scenario was amputation skills. The second scenario was femur fracture skills. The third scenario was contusion to chest in a pediatric patient. The fourth scenario was electrocution.

On Monday September 16th, 2019 we had our monthly Fire training. Training was hydrant hookup, radio communication with in the crew, hose advancement and mask up. One firefighter will get off at the hydrant and connect the LDH and the Engine will pull 200 ft of LDH off. The operator will disconnect the LDH from the rest and connect to the truck. The Officer has to complete a 360 of the scene to figure out a plan. The other two firefighters will grab a cross lay and advance the hose and call for water and mask up. This all has to be completed within 3 minutes.

On Monday September 30th, 2019 we had our quarterly combined training. The training was search and rescue and suspension rescue. Every year we train on search and rescue with the amount of hunting that happens in our area. The members work as a team and walk through the area to try to locate a patient that is hurt. Once they find the patient they need to treat life threating injuries and then figure out the best way to remove that patient from that location. We also used the drone. With having the drone we were able to find the patient within minutes. We used rescue Randy and placed him in a harness and was suspended about 8 feet up in a tree. The EMS had to assess the patient when the fire members were figuring out a way of getting him down. We used our low angle rescue equipment to get the patient down. This is all done with ropes and pulleys.

This month two of our members had completed the EMT course and now have completed their national registry testing. These two members now can run on ambulance calls.







ORDINANCE 2019-08 (REDLINED FORMAT)

Adding Warehousing, Under Certain Conditions, As A Permitted Use In Commercial (C-1) Zoning Districts

The City Council of the City of Waterloo, Jefferson County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 385-12(A) is hereby amended to add warehousing as a permitted use to the municipal code with the section remainder renumbered. It reads as follows:

§ 385-12 C-1 General Commercial District.

The C-1 District is intended to provide an area for the business and commercial needs of the City.

A. Permitted uses.

(1) Post offices.

(2) General business and commercial uses which do not generate noise, smoke or odors that would create a public or private nuisance. These uses generally include the following:

- (a) Banks, commercial or professional offices and telephone offices.
- (b) Hotels and motels.
- (c) Places of amusement and theaters.
- (d) Personal service, automobile service, and equipment service establishments.
- (e) Bus depots.
- (f) Parking lots.

(g) Warehousing of 5,000 sq. ft. or less, when an area equal to, or greater than the same area on the same parcel is used as non-warehousing commercial use.

(g)(h) Uses customarily incident to any of the above uses.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting as provided by law.

RESOLUTION #2019-32 Resolution Requesting Exemption from County Library Tax

WHEREAS the City of Waterloo will, in 2020, appropriate and expend an amount in excess of that calculated above,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Waterloo hereby requests of the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors that the City of Waterloo be exempted from the payment of any tax for the support of the County Library Service as provided in Section 43.64 (2).
