#### **HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE:**

The special event or entertainment sponsor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Waterloo, Wisconsin, its agents, public officials, officers, employees and authorized volunteers, from and against any and all legal actions, claims, damages, losses, expenses arising out of the permitted event/activity or any activity associated with the conduct of the sponsor's operation of the event, including but not limited to, claims for personal or bodily injury, disease or death, or injury to or destruction of property, excluding claims caused by the willful commission or omission by employees of the City of Waterloo acting within the scope of their employment.

Further, the event sponsor agrees to indemnify the City of Waterloo and any of its agents, public officers, officials or employees and authorized volunteers for any attorneys fees and court costs incurred or to be incurred in defending any actions brought against them as a result of the sponsor's use of public property or operation of the event as set forth in the application for special permit.

#### CITY OF WATERLOO INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIAL EVENTS

- 1. The City of Waterloo requires submission of a Certificate of Insurance along with the Special or Entertainment Events Application prior to review by the City's Government Operations Committee.
- 2. The Certificate of Insurance must include the following **minimum** limits of insurance coverage required for special events on City property:

\$300,000 Injury or death of one person; \$1,000,000 for any one accident; \$50,000 for Property Damage.

- 3. The City of Waterloo must be named on the Certificate of Insurance as **primary**, **non-contributory additional insured** under the general liability policy for the event.
- 4. The Certificate of Insurance must include the name of the special event, and the date, time and location of the event.
- 5. The City of Waterloo reserves the right to request a copy of the actual policy represented by the Certificate of Insurance.
- 6. No event will be allowed to proceed without receipt by the City of a valid Certificate of Insurance in full compliance with the above listed requirements.
