Unb surve were antici	beknownst to you, we have incurred some additional costs related to the certified y map approval at 123 South Monroe Street. Engineering time and attorney fees expended because the City needs to formally "vacate" the public right-of-way. I pate fees at roughly \$500 for this. We rarely vacate property. The City Attorney many municipal clients) said he typically writes-in a provision requiring the land								

recipient to incur the engineering and legal fees. We did not have any such arrangement, because my view was it was such an small land area.

• Additionally, for the contemplated land sale, we would incur the expense of amending

the parcel boundaries as described immediately below and associated closing documents. I anticipate roughly \$300 for these survey and legal fees.
☐ The southern end of the subject property with the storm water basin gets segmented out and remains a municipal responsibility.
☐ We skip the provision of the DPW providing gravel.
 Why? We don't have ready access to gravel and would just have to buy and have it delivered.
I'm not exactly sure if it will be determined by the Mayor and governing body that it is advisable to sell this land. But if it is and you are amenable to modifications listed above, we could be in a position to close on the transaction in December.


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


