

On Monday, November 11th, 2019 we had our monthly EMS training. We trained on hypothermia, frostbite and EMS Jeopardy. Our members reviewed the protocols and trained on how to manage hypothermia and frostbite victims. We review pictures to see what the stages of frostbite are and how we would treat it. EMS Jeopardy reviews all EMS areas. This is a nice little competition and good team work training.

On Monday, November 18th, 2019 we had our monthly Fire training. We had a live burn training. Our old smoke house that we used for teaching kids how to get out of their house when there is smoke got damaged last year from water. When we have these live burns there are multiple trainings that we are accomplishing such as radio communications, water supply, pumping operations, exposure protection, hose deployment, air consumption awareness, accountability and incident command system.

This month one of our members completed and became a certified Officer I.
