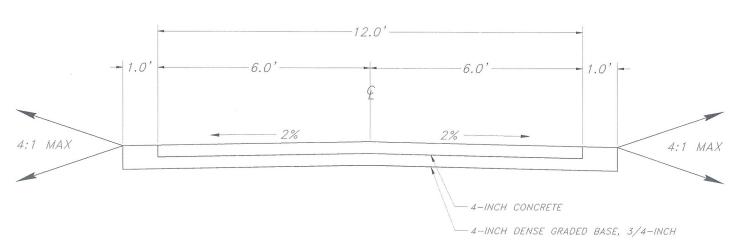








HOT MIX ASPHALT PEDESTRIAN PATH TYPICAL CROSS—SECTION

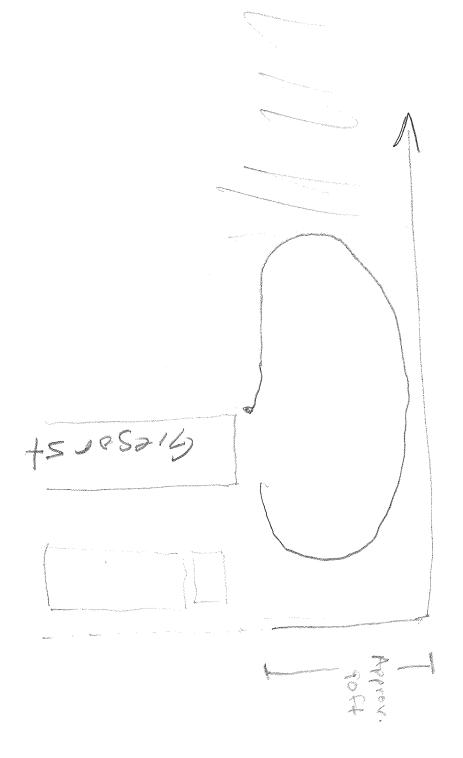
