



Authorizing A Department Of Natural Resources 2022 Lead Water Service Program Grant
Application And Establishing 2022 Program Details For A DNR Funded Municipal Private Lead Water
Service Replacement Program

The Common Council of the City of Waterloo, Wisconsin does hereby resolve as follows:

Whereas, the City of Waterloo Comprehensive Plan calls for Waterloo to be a Green and Healthy Community, and;

Whereas, the Federal Environmental Protection Agency has set the maximum contaminant level goal for lead in drinking water at zero because lead is a toxic metal that can be harmful to human health even at low exposure levels. Lead is persistent, and it can bioaccumulate in the body over time, and;

Whereas, Waterloo Utilities has found elevated levels of lead in drinking water in some homes and buildings. Lead can cause serious health problems, especially for pregnant women and young children. By removing lead water services in-home water quality will improve, and;

Whereas, the Clerk/Treasurer's office seeks to apply for 2022 funding from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to aid private property owners in the removal of lead water services, administered by the Clerk/Treasurer's office

Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Waterloo City Council takes the following action:

NOTES - The DNR is expected to notify those community receiving 2022 funding by mid to late March

- 1. Directs the Clerk/Treasurer to submit a 2022 grant application to the DNR, and directs the Mayor, Clerk/Treasurer & Deputy Clerk/Treasurer to review and sign all documents related to the grant.
- 2. Upon receipt of notice from the DNR of an affirmative award for this year, it authorizes the immediate implementation of a 2022 Municipal Lead Service Line Replacement Program in accordance with Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources program requirements as has been administered in 2021 with the following grant allocation modification:
 - a. Municipal grant awards benefitting qualifying properties are to cover 75% of qualify contractor costs with no maximum award amount.
