- CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL. Thomas called the meeting to order at 6:01p.m. Members in person or remote: Thomas and Kuhl. Absent: Weihert. Other attending in person or remote: Mayor Quimby; Police Chief Sorenson; Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Tschanz; Public Works Director; Utility Superintendent Sorenson; City Clerk Ritter; Library Director Mountford; Waterloo Utilities Office Mgr Bisco; David Ferris from Ehlers.
- 2. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES: Motion to approve May 19, 2022 & June 7, 2022 MOTION: [Kuhl/Thomas] to approve all meeting minutes as listed. VOICE VOTE: Motion carried.

City could ask them to pay their portion sooner and they would. Ferris stated this shouldn't make a difference for loan rates for the City. Voice Vote: motion carried.
