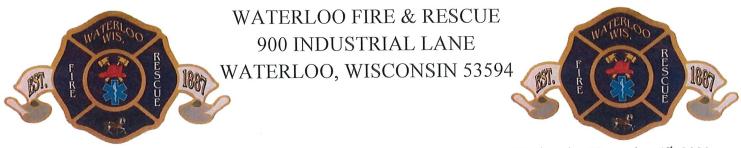

Wednesday November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023

On Monday October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023 we had our monthly Operator training. Training was on maintenance. Members had to show how to check all truck and pump fluids, belts and levers. Shown and practiced how to test the equipment to make sure all trucks and pumps are working properly and are in ready mode.

On Monday October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2023 we had our monthly EMS training. Training was on quarterlies with Medical Director. Medical Director went through and we completed QA on EMS runs. We also trained on where the equipment is and how and when to use certain equipment.

On Monday October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023 we had our monthly Fire training. Training was on FIT testing, chimney fire and gas monitors. Every year we have to test out on our SCBA mask to be an interior firefighter. Members were shown and practiced how to use the chimney fire equipment. We went through how to use the Sensit gas monitor and the laser gas monitor. We also went through what the gas limits mean and what they can to do people if there are in those limits

On Monday October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023 we had our quarterly Combination training. Training was on Search and Rescue. This year we were able to go out to Trek Trails and complete a search and rescue. Sun Prairie EMS was also training with our fire and EMS. The members have to work as a team and communicate. Once patient is found, the crew needs to figure out the best way to move the patient out of the woods and to the UTV rescue unit so they can be transported to the ambulance.
